

Find 52: The Road to Reading National Relay, St Lucia July 3-5, 2018

Once again Richard Clewes, along with other long distance and elite runners from Canada and St Lucia, will run around the island to raise funds and awareness for literacy programs.

The 3-day run is fully supported with police escort, ambulance and road crew personnel. Our athletic trainer will provide support with injury prevention and post-run rehabilitation.

St Lucian students join the main group of runners at relay 'transition zones' then run one-mile segments. A "rabbit" runner will guide students behind

Richard. "Turtle" runners follow students to ensure they do not fall behind and assist them onto shuttle buses if necessary.

"Rabbits" and "Turtles" keep students safe along the route, avoiding traffic, tripping and heat exhaustion.

Volunteer runners can choose their own daily distances

for each day but they must be committed to run or provide road crew assistance throughout the entire event. Any combination of daily distances is permitted. For example, a runner can choose to run three 5K segments

during one day and then provide road crew support for the remainder of the same day. Or you could complete a half-marathon on the first day, and then complete a 10K on each of the remaining two days. The choice is yours.

When not running, we need volunteer runners to assist school groups at transition zones, or to deliver water and nutrition at predetermined stops along the route.

When students are on course, we'll maintain at least 2 "Rabbits" and "Turtles." (Volunteer runners

rotate as rest and rehydration is required.)

Volunteer runners are accommodated based on double occupancy in a beautiful, five-bedroom villa at Stonefield Estate in Soufrière, our headquarters for the event. You and a roommate may have to share a King or Queen bed. Some rooms have two twin beds.

Trip Costs

Total cost is \$3,000* per person. This includes:

Direct return airfare from Toronto 7 nights hotel shared accommodation at Stonefield Estate, Soufrière Meal plan in Saint Lucia, including two alcoholic drinks with dinner. (In-flight meals are not included.) Ground transportation in St. Lucia to and from airports and daily start/finish sites
